# Staggered Entry - Kindergarten

- Tuesday, September 14<sup>th</sup> all kindergarten students attend

### **Bell Times**


Please be aware that our bell times have changed slightly:

#### **COVID Information**

The Return to School Operational Plan includes:

## Continued protocols to reduce transmission of COVID-19 and other respiratory illnesses:

- Students, staff, and visitors must use the daily health checklist before coming to school and stay home when sick
- Students and staff who become ill at school are required to go home
- Promote and facilitate hand hygiene and respiratory etiquette
- Enhanced ventilation measures
- Enhanced cleaning and disinfecting of high traffic/touch areas

#### **Health restrictions lifted:**

- Masks will not be required in schools. RVS will support students and staff in their choice to wear/not wear a mask in our schools and offices. (Masks will be required on school buses)
- Cohorting and physical distancing will not be required in schools
- School events such as assemblies, graduations and team sports may resume
- Student use of lockers is permitted
- As per government requirements, close contacts are no longer required to isolate and may come to school unless they are symptomatic or told by Alberta Health Services that they must quarantine

As always, the health and safety of all Wildcats is our top priority. We will continue to take direction from Rocky View Schools and Alberta Health Services in terms of COVID protocols.
