PRINCIPAL'S MESSAGE - MS. CHRISTINE PARKER

Friday, January 8th

Welcome Back, I hope the first week of school in 2021 went well from your home and that teachers and staff were able to support you and your child/children! I hope everyone has had a great break and had a chance to unplug and relax.

We are prepared and excited and looking forward to transitioning back to face-to-face inschool learning on Monday, January 11th. We are still following all of AHS protocols and want to remind you what we need from you, to help us all stay safe.

1. It is important that every morning you complete a Daily Check-in with each of your children and keep them home if they have any of the symptoms on the list.

Masks must be worn from grades 4 to 8 on the bus and at school. We also 2. recommend that K to 3 students wear masks where social distancing is not possible. 3. Hand washing and sanitizing will continue to be an expectation.

- 4. Physical Distancing where possible.
- 5. No sharing of food or other items.

6. Travel outside of Canada – Requirements – All students who have traveled outside of Canada must follow AHS quarantine requirements and check-in with the school to coordinate any additional requirements and return to school dates.

7. Parents and Caregivers need to remain in their vehicle's when they are dropping off students. If there is a need to get out of your car, masks must be worn.

Monday January 11th marks the beginning of the selection period for families to choose the learning mode for the second half of the school year. The deadline to change learning modes is Friday January 15th with no exceptions. Please note, because Rocky View Schools (RVS) adjusted the selection period into January for grades 1 to 8 families, the switch-over date for grades 1 to 8 will be February 8th. It is also important to note that the time requirements and expectations of students participating in RVS Online Learning are different than the temporary online learning students have currently completed with their Westbrook teacher and it is recommend all families interested in changing learning modes review RVS website and the provided links. RVS understands this is a difficult decision for some families, therefore additional information to support you is available on the RVS website. This includes updates to the COVID-19 Information for 2020/21 School Year section of our website, an updated overview of RVS Online Learning offered and a video walking you through how to make your selection using SchoolEngage through the PowerSchool Parent Portal. We have included the RVS letter with this newsletter and will also be sending the RVS letter out to all families Friday January 8th.

Improving emotional health and well being

Mindfulness Supporting Your Child's Social and Emotional Well-being

Crystal Dittrick, Ph.D., R.Psych., CCC. Ashely Meagher, BA

This session will explore the topic of mindfulness and how mindfulness strategies can help support their child's social and emotional well-being. Explore how our brain's stress responses (fight, flight, or freeze) may impact our social and emotional well-being and how we can use mindfulness to calm our brain. We will discuss how the brain influences thinking, emotions, self-regulation, and behaviour. Improved social emotional skills using mindfulness can lead to better focus in school, better cooperation with others, improved self-awareness, self-regulation, decrease stress/anxiety, and improve our overall sense of well-being. Through an interactive session, participants will be guided through some mindfulness activities that they can use with their children and explore learning from the MindUP program.

The period to decide the learning method (in-school or online) for students in Grades 1 to 9* this spring is quickly approaching. SchoolEngage will open at 8 a.m. on Jan. 11. Families will have until 5 p.m. on Jan. 15 to commit your child to a learning method from Feb. 8, 2021, until the end of the school year. If no selection is made, those students will remain in their current learning method.

*Grade 9s at Chestermere Lake Middle, Indus, Langdon, W.G. Murdoch, Prince of Peace and Beiseker will make their selection between Jan. 11 and 15 given how their timetable is arranged; Grade 9s in high schools have already made their selections.
