PRINCIPAL'S MESSAGE -MS. CHRISTINE PARKER

The weather has been great this last week and it is hard to believe that it is November. It feels like spring not fall. We need to remember that winter is on its way and that students are going to have to dress for winter. It is important that students are prepared for the change in weather and dress appropriately, as they will be going outside for two recess periods a day with the longest recess being 25 minutes. All students, even middle school ones need to have a proper winter jacket, gloves, hat, and boots. Additionally, students must keep a second pair of shoes at school for indoor use and physical education.

It has been quiet at the school with a number of our students required to isolate. Students, parents and staff did an amazing job of adjusting to the online environment. Thank you to everyone for engaging and working hard over the past two weeks. We missed all of you and it is great to have everyone back in the building.

As you are aware AHS has changed the <u>Daily health screening for children under</u> <u>18</u>. All staff and adults that work in the building will continue to use the previous AHS daily check list. Students in grades 4 to 8 are doing a great job of wearing their masks on the bus and in the school. This will continue to be an important focus.
